

# BLAINE COUNTY AMBULANCE POLICY

September 25, 2024

ATTENDANT RATES: \$14.00 an hour per attendant

BASE RATE:

- Basic Life Support: \$400.00 Resident, \$550.00 Non-Resident
- Advanced Life Support: \$450.00 Resident, \$600.00 Non-Resident
- Scheduled Transport: \$200.00
- Standby: \$50.00 per hour + state rate mileage (in county)  
\$60.00 per hour + state rate mileage (out of county)

Mileage: \$5.00 per loaded mile

Disposable Supplies: Varies, subject to cost

Medications: Varies, subject to cost

Two or More Patients: When transported in one ambulance charge base rate and supplies to each patient. Mileage is split equally among patients.

Waiting time at hospital: Ambulance will not wait to transport a patient home except in the case of a scheduled transport.


Standbys: For sporting events two people per event will be paid. If the ambulance is needed elsewhere, it will leave the event.


Refusing treatment: Patient must sign a release form. If the patient is a minor, the parent or guardian must sign the form. If a parent is unavailable law enforcement is to be notified.

Miscellaneous: If there is any reason to believe a patient is violent, carrying a weapon, or could be a threat to ambulance personnel, request law enforcement to assist.

Trip Reports: Trip reports need to be submitted to Trisha Huestis at the Blaine County Treasurer's Office weekly.


